Step-by-step plan for cup collection and recycling

Since 2024, new rules apply to the use of disposable cups. The use of disposable cardboard cups is only permitted if they are recycled. The Human Environment and Transport Inspectorate (ILT) monitors compliance with these rules. The process for collecting and recycling cups in this step-by-step plan complies with the legal requirements.

Coffee Fresh Beaumont is pleased to offer customers a comprehensive solution for the collection and recycling of Coffee Fresh coffee cups. We offer this solution in collaboration with BekerVriend, which takes care of collecting the cups you collect.



Follow these steps:

1 Use a low-PE (5%) cup

At Coffee Fresh Beaumont you order cardboard cups that contain a maximum of 5% plastic (PE). This is stated on the cup. You can also find a statement from the manufacturer in the webshop.

2 Register ILT

Use and recycling of cardboard cups with a maximum of 5% plastic is based on a legal exception. To qualify for this exception, you must register with the ILT.

During the registration process with the ILT, you will be asked, among other

things: "How can you demonstrate that the processing of the collected plastic cups is truly of high quality, as intended in the scheme?" Here you answer 'Declaration of Conformity'. Then upload the following statement as an attachment:

3 Collect with TrackerSack

The recycling process that Coffee Fresh Beaumont offers in collaboration with BekerVriend works on the basis of so-called TrackerSacks of 60 liters. These bags are available in the webshop: <u>TrackerSack: rol à 25 zakken € 56,25</u> The TrackerSack (article nr 430213) can be used in combination with the Close Future collection bins and the cardboard cup grids for these bins.

Collect cups at the work location

For collecting the cups you can use Close Future collection bins. This is available with a grid or inlay (cardboard or metal) in which the cups are efficiently stacked. By placing the TrackerSack around the inlay in the collection bin, you make optimal use of the space in the TrackerSack.

You can choose the most suitable solution for cup collection at the workplace. For recycling it is only necessary that the cups are offered in a (closed) TrackerSack.

Order collection bins

- 5 Check your full TrackerSacks
 - The bags may only contain low-PE cardboard cups.
 - There should be only minimal contamination in the cups. If present If there is too much pollution, collection may be refused.
- 6 Register with BekerVriend

Full TrackerSacks are picked up by BekerVriend. To do this, create a pickup order online. Under 'Partner of', select Coffee Fresh from the list. Our TrackerSacks are 'small', so you also select this option.

7 Offer bags for collection

After creating and paying for the collection order, you will receive a confirmation from BekerVriend with the planned collection date.

8 Checking bags by collection driver

When collecting, the driver scans the barcodes on the bags and checks them for contamination. If one or more bags are deemed too contaminated, the bags in question may not be taken.

Track and register the collected bags

To comply with legal requirements, you must keep a record of the cups you purchase and recycle. You can use the registration form below for this.

This form states the net weight of the cups of the various packages that you order from Coffee Fresh Beaumont. Through the TrackerSack system of BekerVriend you follow the weight of the recycled cups, so that you can complete the administration.

10 Recycling

After collection, the cups are stored and transported by container to the recycling company that recycles both the cardboard and the plastic into raw materials for new products, such as paper and plastic bags.
